





Sutherland Sharks FC 0 - Blacktown City FC 2 at Seymour Shaw

Blacktown City FC cruised to a 2-0 victory against Sutherland Sharks during their PlayStation®4 National Premier Leagues NSW Men's clash at Seymour Shaw on Saturday.

Goals to winger James Andrew and Joey Gibbs helped the visitors secure all three points and put the pressure on top side APIA Leichhardt Tigers in the battle for the PlayStation®4 National Premier Leagues NSW Men's Premiership.

It was the Andrew show in the first half as the winger, making his first appearance at Seymour Shaw since leaving the club at the end of last season, terrorised the Sutherland defence in a man of the match performance.

Sutherland's cause wasn't helped by a 35th minute red card from Christopher McStay as they struggled to break down an in form Blacktown outfit.

WARATAH CUP FINALS

MATCHES ANNOUNCED

The 2017 Waratah Cup Finals matches have been announced after round 7 of the Westfield FFA Cup Preliminary Rounds were completed on Wednesday evening as APIA Leichhardt Tigers, Bankstown Berries, Blacktown City, Hills Brumbies, Hakoah Sydney City East and Sydney United 58 were on course to play for this season's first piece of silverware.

The live draw was completed on Friday 2nd of June as the historic NSW Cup, won by Sydney United 58 last season with a 1-0 victory over Manly United at Lambert Park, took centre stage at Football NSW's headquarters.

The Preliminary Finals to be played on Wednesday 14th of July will see current Cup holders Sydney United 58 entertain PlayStation4 National Premier Leagues 2 NSW Men's outfit Bankstown Berries while on the same evening, Hills Brumbies of the PlayStation4 National Premier Leagues 2 NSW Men's competition take on 2016 PS4 NPL NSW Men's Champions Blacktown City FC.

The Semi-Finals were also announced as the winner of the Preliminary Final Match 1 being either Sydney United 58 or Bankstown Berries would host Hakoah Sydney City East while the winner of Preliminary



Final Match 2 being Hills Brumbies or Blacktown City would play home to APIA Leichhardt Tigers on Wednesday 28th of July.

MATCH PREVIEW

Blacktown City will arrive into their meeting with Bonnyrigg with the wind in their sails having beaten leaders Sutherland 2-1 in the previous weekend as John Carnevale's side look to press the premiership claim.

Although massively behind on goal difference, City are only three points behind the leaders going into round fourteen and with APIA Leichhardt Tigers hosting Sutherland at Lambert Park the night before Blacktown will want to capitalize on any dropped points.

Facing Bonnyrigg will be a different proposition though, with the White Eagles winning back to back matches against Sydney Olympic and Manly United in the last fortnight. In addition to a 2-0 triumph over City in round three, Hamish Brown's side were also 4-0 and 8-0 victors over their opponents in the 2016 season and will fancy their chances continuing their mid-season revival at Lilys Football Centre.


