FROM THE CLUB



MATCH PREVIEW

MATCH PREVIEW

Sutherland Sharks are enduring their toughest spell of the campaign so far and face another tricky fixture on Sunday when they face a Rockdale side aiming for their fourth win in a row.

The Suns beat Sydney Olympic 2-1 last Sunday to breathe new life into a season which has flickered with promise but so far failed to make Rockdale genuine contenders. The Ilinden side are the lowest scorers (15) only to Parramatta (12) but victories over Olympic, Hakoah Sydney City East and Sydney United 58 have the Suns back in the mix for the top five.

Another victory over Sutherland would represent a big statement of intent from the hosts who can smell blood in the water with the competition leaders losing three of their last four matches against Hakoah and fellow contenders APIA Leichhardt and Blacktown City.

However, the quality of the ladder leaders was emphasized clearly in the round six meeting between the two teams which saw Sutherland beat Rockdale 7-0 at Seymour Shaw. With

Blacktown City and Sydney FC snipping away at their lead by the week, the Sharks need to summon a performance of similar magnitude to get their premiership assault back on track.
