

The sudden departure of Portuguese head coach Jaime Monroy proved no distraction for the visitors as they notched their fifth win of the season in impressive style.

Olympic gave their travelling fans a performance to be proud of as they raced out of the block with Yu Kuboki and Radovan Pavicevic finding the net during the first half.

APIA struggled to find their way into the way during what was a lethargic performance from Danial Cummins' top of the table side. A late goal from tricky winger Corey Bizco proved to be a mere consolation for the home side as they suffered only their second defeat of the season.



Sydney United 58 has piled more misery on Parramatta FC with a one sided 5-0 thrashing at Sydney United Sports Centre on Sunday.
