The synthetic project is the biggest infrastructure project undertaken at the llinden Sports Centre since our relocation almost 8 years ago. It will allow us to fulfil our goal of providing young aspiring Rockdale players with a quality, durable, all weather playing surface that we have craved for so long.

To say that this is a special moment in our history is an understatement and I cannot thank enough those committed former Councillors of Rockdale City Council who had the vision, drive and shared passion to see the project come to fruition. game for us against a red-hot Wolves side. Our boys come into the game following a 1-1 away draw against the competition leaders Blacktown. It was a game I felt we should of won given the number of chances we created.

There is much to play for and we look forward to today's game.

In the lower grades, our under 18s will be looking to cement 2nd position on the ladder, whilst our under 20s, who were unlucky to only secure a point last week, will be looking for a win to hopefully catapult them back into the top 5.


