1ST GRADE MATCH PREVIEW

The chance to bounce back from two tough weeks will be at the forefront of the Blacktown City players minds when the host Marconi Stallions at Lily Homes Stadium on Saturday night.

A 1-0 loss to Sydney Olympic last week and a 1-1 draw with Manly United in Round 5 has taken the wind out of their sails.

But if any team is to fire back better than ever it is Blacktown City.

One challenge facing City will be the absence of captain Matt Lewis for the clash with Marconi after he was given a red card against Olympic.

Lewis has anchored the midfield for the past season and a half but that responsibility is likely to be handed to central midfield partner Connor Evans.

Despite not receiving the plaudits of some of his higher profile teammates, Evans' hardworking

displays has helped transition defence into attack.

their opponents Marconi have slowed in recent weeks after a strong start to the season.

A 1-1 draw with Hakoah last week continued their struggles finding a cutting edge in matches but there are still positive signs for the historic club.

Marko Jesic was the standout performer for Marconi in Round 6 and the former A-League striker is a player which can open up a defence when he is on song.

If Jesic can rediscover his eye for goal then he would be a good bet to find the back of the net against Blacktown.

Blacktown will be favourites for this match, but Marconi has enough experience and star power of their own to mount an upset.

Sydney Olympic 1-5 Blacktown City, 12.40pm at Belmore Sports Ground

Blacktown City rolled to its fourth consecutive victory after defeating strugglers Sydney Olympic 5-1 at Belmore Sports Ground.

John Carnevale's side hit the net through Lachlan Rose who struck his third goal in as many weeks, with Jack Stewart, Adolph Koudakpo, John Azar and William Salinas completing the rout for City.

The result means Blacktown leapfrog Sydney FC and Sydney United 58 in second position and are three points behind leaders Sutherland Sharks.

Ahmad Safdari scored the lone effort for Sydney Olympic who slumped to their fourth defeat from five matches.

Next up for the Blues is a match against Rockdale City Suns at Belmore Sportsground on Sunday lunchtime.

Marconi Stallions 0-3 Hakoah Sydney City East, 5.00pm at Marconi Stadium

Hakoah Sydney City East have won back to back matches for the first time this season following an impressive 3-0 victory over Marconi at Marconi Stadium on Saturday afternoon.

Paul Hubbard's side opened their account for the season thanks to a 3-2 victory over Wollongong Wolves last week and were far too superior for Marconi, with Finley Hayhurst, Jordan Makridopolus and Connor Eldridge all getting their names on the scoresheet.

Having notched 14 goals to lead Hakoah's finals charge last season, the goal for Eldridge is his first effort of the season and should prove to be a key moment for the improving Hakoah side and their top marksman.

Hakoah are now level on points with Marconi in seventh position ahead of a match with Sydney United 58 at Hensley Athletic Field next Saturday.

The defeat for Marconi is their first defeat since opening the campaign with a 2-1 loss against Sydney United 58 – the Stallions will look to get back on track next Saturday when they take on Blacktown City.
