We wish them well, as too our Under 18 and 20 squads who have had a tough start to the season, but are working hard to overturn this.

Football NSW recently released information regarding proposed 2019 competition structures with the main points in relation to the Senior Competitions included below;

The Football NSW Board resolved that the following structure for Men's Senior Competitions will apply for 2019 and the following seasons.

- Four divisions consisting of:
 - NSW National Premier League
 - NSW National Premier League 2
 - NSW National Premier League 3
 - NSW National Premier League 4
- 12 Clubs per division
- Each division comprises U20 and 1st Grade
- League tables maintained for the Premiership series
- Five-team Championship Series to determine Champion
- Senior level promotion and relegation to be based on standings of 1st Grade premiership only and be applied as follows: - Last place (12th) in NPL, NPL 2 and NPL 3 to be relegated; - First Place (1st) in NPL 2, NPL 3 and NPL 4 to be promoted; and - Second-Last Place (11th) in NPL, NPL 2, and NPL 3 will enter a promotion/relegation playoff against a club from the division below, format to be determined

- Senior Club Championship to consist of U20 and 1st Grade only and will not impact promotion/relegation

Our Club's position in the 2019 Men's Senior NSW NPL will be determined by the club championship model that you are familiar with from previous seasons and is part of the 2018 competition regulations.

There has also been some changes to the Men's Youth League structure for 2019, Under 18's will headline our Youth Football program and will sit over our underpinning Under 13, 14, 15 and 16 programs. An equally weighted club championship (based on the 2018 Under 14, 15 and 16 competitions) will determine the Youth League our club is accepted into for 2019 and going forward there will be promotion and relegation throughout these four Leagues also.

The club will continue to work towards ensuring we are ready for these changes both at Senior and Youth level and give ourselves the best opportunity for success on and off the field.

We would like to welcome all our sponsors, season pass holders and supporters today and thank them for their ongoing support. A club cannot exist without these people and we look forward to working with you to continue the growth of our Club both this season and into the future. As I said last week, let's grow the crowd together, we need to all play our part and get in touch with your networks of friends and family to turn up, show your support and watch this squad and our great Club in action.

Boasting a strong midfield, composed defence and clinical strikers, Sydney Olympic have the squad to make a serious mark on the competition in 2018.

Look for Max Burgess to go to new heights again this week on the back of his match winning performance against Blacktown.

Will Angel will be missed by Olympic as he

serves his one match ban after seeing red last round. Saad has plenty of players on his bench able to fill the void for this match.

This week they will be out to add further woe to a spluttering Rockdale outfit who will still be hurting after coming away with only a draw with Manly United last week despite leading 3-0 after 30 minutes.

Paul Reid's side has the fire power and quality on the park to beat anyone, but poor discipline and lapses in concentration have cost them this season.

Alec Urosevski remains the Suns biggest threat in attack with the pacy midfielder a challenging prospect for any opposition defence.

If Rockdale plays to its ability and can keep it together for 90 minutes than they have the stock to cause an upset, in saying that Olympic will start as favourites and will be expected to carry on their winning run.

Sydney Olympic 1-5 Blacktown City, 12.40pm at Belmore Sports Ground

Blacktown City rolled to its fourth consecutive victory after defeating strugglers Sydney Olympic 5-1 at Belmore Sports Ground.

John Carnevale's side hit the net through Lachlan Rose who struck his third goal in as many weeks, with Jack Stewart, Adolph Koudakpo, John Azar and William Salinas completing the rout for City.

The result means Blacktown leapfrog Sydney FC and Sydney United 58 in second position and are three points behind leaders Sutherland Sharks.

Ahmad Safdari scored the lone effort for Sydney Olympic who slumped to their fourth defeat from five matches.

Next up for the Blues is a match against Rockdale City Suns at Belmore Sportsground on Sunday lunchtime.

Blacktown City host Marconi Stallions at Lily's Football Centre on Saturday night.

Manly United and Rockdale City Suns settled for a 1-1 stalemate at Cromer Park on Saturday afternoon.

The hosts were on the scoresheet through William Martin but Rockdale's Dimitrios Petratos notched his second goal of the season to earn a point for the City Suns.

The result leaves in tenth position ahead of a crunch match with bottom placed Sydney Olympic next Sunday lunchtime.

Manly are level with the Suns on five competition points but a vastly superior goal difference sees the Cromer Park outfit in eighth position.
