# 1ST GRADE MATCH PREVIEW

**B**lacktown City will be determined to rediscover their free scoring ways when they host Sydney United 58 on Sunday.

City's struggles in hitting the back of the net cost them last round against Wollongong Wolves and they were forced to settle for a 1-1 draw despite having more than their fair share of chances.

United 58 were also forced to share the points in Round 12 with a 2-2 draw against Marconi Stallions.

Joey Gibbs has quietly been going about his work for Mark Crittenden's Blacktown side this season but has once again lead the line with aplomb. He was a constant threat last week and should've scored more than just the one goal he netted in the draw.

The big news from Edensor Park coming into this clash is the hire of Miro Vlastelica as United 58's new head coach.

The side has been without a manager since the resignation of Jason Culina after their Round 8 loss to fierce rivals Bonnyrigg White Eagles. Vlastelica will have plenty of work to do if he is to get the side firing on all cylinders ahead of this big clash.

One headache will be the loss of Nick Stavroulakis who was starting to find his form after an injury riddled start to the season – the club captain saw red against the Marconi Stallions and will sit this match out although alot of pressure will be placed on the shoulders of one Panny Nikas.

Blacktown will be the favourites going into this matchup with their endless supply of attacking weapons and experienced defenders making them a very difficult team to defeat.

However, they have had their moments of weakness this season and if United 58 can take their chances could be in with a chance of snatching an upset.

Wilkshire scored his first goal for the Wolves since making his return to the club where he made his breakthrough to deny Blacktown a vital three points.

Joey Gibbs had the home side in the box seat when he hit the back of the net on the 40 minute mark to give his side a 1-0 lead.

However, Blacktown was unable to kill off the fixture and paid the price when the former Socceroos World Cup star struck after 61 minutes to secure a point for a resurgent Wolves.

# FFA CUP ROUND OF 32

#NPLNSW

Five NPL NSW Men's top tier clubs qualify for Round of 32.

Five clubs from NSW have booked their spot in the FFA Cup Round of 32 on Wednesday night.

APIA Leichhardt Tigers, Marconi Stallions, Bonnyrigg White Eagles, Hakoah Sydney City East and Rockdale City Suns all made it through to the national stage.

APIA ran out 3-0 winners over a hapless Sydney Olympic to secure back-to-back Round of 32 berths.

Marconi and Bonnyrigg faced tougher opposition, despite playing sides in lower divisions.

Hills United put up a solid fight against Bonnyrigg, while GHFA Spirit showed, well, plenty of spirit against Marconi.

However, both top-tier sides were able to show their class and advance with 2-1 wins.

Hakoah also played weaker opposition in the Tarrawanna Blueys, and the South Coast side were unable to continue their fairytale run, with Hakoah sealing a 4-0 win.

All the drama was in Rockdale, however, with the Suns securing a dramatic late win.

With 10 minutes left on the clock, it looked like Blacktown were going to continue their run of reaching the Final Rounds of the FFA Cup.

But Rockdale had other ideas, levelling the scores at 2-2 in the 81st minute.

And it was not until the 91st minute that they took the lead in the match for the first time, converting a penalty to book their spot in the Round of 32.

The draw for the Round of 32 will take place on Tuesday, 26 June and will be broadcast on FOX SPORTS.

**B**lacktown City host Sydney United 58 at Lily Homes Stadium on Sunday afternoon needing a big performance to restore their faltering title bid.

John Carnevale's side were defeated 3-0 by Wollongong Wolves in Seven Hills last round in a double blow for Blacktown, with leaders Sutherland slipping up at home to Rockdale the day before. That heavy defeat to the Wolves made it back to back 3-0 losses for City, who were comfortably beaten by the competition leaders the previous round.

With Sutherland still six points ahead of Blacktown and Hakoah Sydney City East, Wollongong and Sydney FC all closing in on City, anything less than a win over Sydney United 58 on Sunday could have severe ramifications in the long run for the second-placed outfit.

They'll face a resurgent Sydney United 58 side who after losing six matches in a row have now secured consecutive victories over Sydney

Olympic and Marconi. The Reds are now just four points away from fifth position and know claiming the scalp of Blacktown could do wonders for their campaign.
