#### 1ST GRADE MATCH PREVIEW

Three points off the bottom of the table but still in sight of finals football, Bonnyrigg White Eagles will be desperate to turn their season around starting with Saturday night's clash against. Sydney Olympic.

Bonnyrigg has struggled this season but are high on confidence after a impressive win against last season's grand final winners Manly United in Round 11.

This week they take on the league leaders Sydney Olympic and will need to bring nothing short of their best performance if they are to stand any chance of claiming an upset.

Olympic come into the game off a solid victory against Sydney United 58 and hold a three point lead at the top of the table.

White Eagles off-season recruit Dean Bereveskos finally hit the target for 2018 after slotting one home against Manly United last Saturday. The skilful attacker could prove to be a key contributor for Bonnyrigg over the second half of the season starting with the clash against Olympic. He alongside Shervin Adeli could slowly form a deadly partnership should the two continue to work together with the absence of striker Aaron Peterson.

The White Eagles will need to back up from its round 6 FFA Cup clash against St George FA on Wednesday so Brian Brown's men will be certainly put through the litmus test.

Thomas Whiteside has been the breakout star for Olympic this campaign with the defender in incredible form. He scored his second goal in as many weeks in round 11 and will be looking to make it three from three against Bonnyrigg.

Nothing more can be said about the club's Spanish star Alejandro Sanchez. The former La Liga player has been in fine form for the Blues and it his link-up play with Max Burgess that has been a sight to see for the Blues.

While the odds will be stacked against Bonnyrigg this week, they should not be written off especially at their cauldron.

#### Bonnyrigg White Eagles 2 – Manly United FC 1 at Bonnyrigg Sports Club

Bonnyrigg White Eagles claimed three much needed competition points with a 2-1 victory over Manly United on Saturday night at Bonnyrigg Sports Ground.

It was a frantic six-minute spell inside the opening 20 minutes that had this match sorted for Brian Brown's men.

Dean Bereveskos, in only his second start of the NPL NSW Men's season, helped the White Eagles off to a flyer before Shervin Adeli doubled their lead with yet another special goal.

A Ben Tosi owns goal allowed Manly United back into the contest but that was all the away side could do as they saw three points slip.



#### Sydney United 58 0 – Sydney Olympic 2 at Sydney United Sports Centre

NPL NSW Men's competition leaders Sydney Olympic underlined their Premiership credentials with a commanding 2-0 victory over 10-man Sydney United 58 at Sydney United Sports Centre on Saturday evening.

Abbas Saad's side entered the encounter riding the crest of an eight-match unbeaten run and extended their advantage at the top of the table after cruising to another three points in what was a heated clash with their fellow competition heavyweights at Edensor Park.

The damage was done in a sensational opening half cameo from the Blues who opened the scoring through Spanish star Alejandro Sanchez before Thomas Whiteside's volley gave the visitors breathing space on the cusp of half time.

Peter Markovic's dismissal early in the second half for an altercation with Sanchez ignited a savagely fought second half between the two former NSL rivals, and although the home side matched Olympic in the battle the visitors proved too streetwise and trotted to their ninth win of the season.

The result ensures the Blues will finish the first half of the regular season in pole position while opening up a 12-point gap over United 58 on the table.
