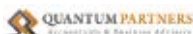

1ST GRADE MATCH PREVIEW

Only a win outside the top five, Hakoah Sydney City East will be determined to stay in the race for finals football when they take on a revitalised Bonnyrigg White Eagles on Sunday.

Hakoah suffered a narrow defeat at the hands of Blacktown City last week and were unlucky to come away from the contest without a point.

Gavin Rae's side had Blacktown on the ropes at times but failed to keep their composure in the dying stages.

Mitchell Stamatellis has been an inspired addition to the squad this year and has filled the role Rae occupied last season before stepping aside to focus on coaching the side for this campaign.

Stamatellis' experience and ability to read the game is second to none and provides a real strength to his side's defence.

He will be put to the test against a fired up Bonnyrigg side fresh from an incredible derby upset over rivals Sydney United 58.

The White Eagles have breathed life back into their stuttering season with improved performances across the board.

Coach Brian Brown will hope to build on the improved morale in the squad with another great showing against Hakoah.

After two successive victories, Brown's men will hope that they can make it three on the bounce.

Ben Tosi was impressive against Sydney United 58 as was David Vrankovic and Zac Mackenzie.

Both sides a very evenly matched and the result could easily go either way.

At Home Hakoah would be slim favourites, but don't write off a Bonnyrigg side flying high on confidence.

Blacktown City 3 – Hakoah Sydney City East 2 at Lily Homes Stadium

Blacktown City ended a three-match winless run with a 3-2 victory over Hakoah Sydney City East in a heated encounter at Lily's Football Centre on Saturday evening.

Two goals in a three minute spell before half time proved critical for Blacktown who established a 2-0 buffer at the break thanks to Joey Gibbs' back post header and Grant Lynch's clever finish from close range.

A see-sawing second half saw Duncan Stewart bring Hakoah back into contention from the penalty spot before Blacktown restored their two goal advantage through a stunning Yianni Spyarakis goal midway through the period.

Substitute Anthony Frangie pulled a goal back for the visitors to ensure it would be a tense final ten minutes but Blacktown held on to secure their first league win since a victory over APIA Leichhardt Tigers in late May.



Bonnyrigg White Eagles 2 – Sydney United 58 at Bonnyrigg Sports Club

It was derby delight for Bonnyrigg White Eagles after they snatched a 2-1 win against fierce rivals Sydney United 58 on Sunday.

It was a huge victory for the White Eagles who followed up with their second successive victory while for United 58, it was Jason Culina's second successive loss.

Ben Tosi gave the White Eagles the perfect start when he opened the scoring for the home side after 26 minutes, before Shervin Adeli stretched their lead to 2-0 midway through the second stanza.

United 58 struggled without their star playmaker Panny Nikas and claimed a mere consolation goal in the dying stages of the match as Bonnyrigg secured derby bragging rights.

Hakoah are nonetheless equal on points with fifth-placed Sydney United 58 and will have designs on ending round nine in the top five with a win over the White Eagles.

It won't be easy against a resurgent Bonnyrigg side likely to be buoyed by a superb 2-0 win over Sydney United 58 last Sunday. The derby win was also a second straight clean sheet for Hamish Brown's men – the eighth-placed White Eagles will need to keep up their excellent defensive improvement in order to leave the Eastern Suburbs unscathed.

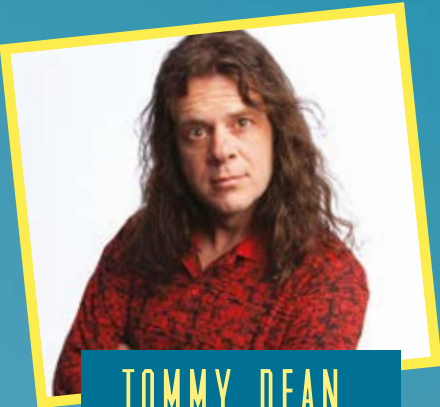

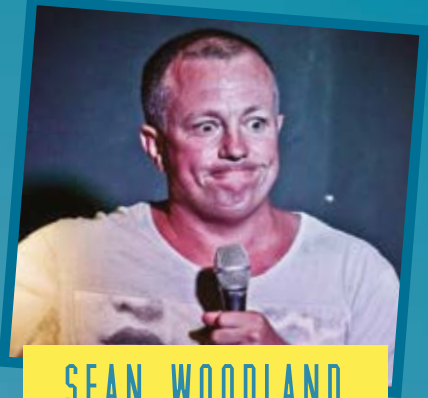
