Sutherland Sharks host Blacktown City tonight and we welcome their players, supporters and officials to Seymour Shaw tonight. Both teams had wins at their last start. The Sharks had a convincing 2-0 win against a strong Marconi outfit last week while Blacktown defeated Sydney 1-0. Both clubs are high up in the club championship so all three games (18's, 20's & 1sts) will be keenly contested.

Joshua Da Silva showed his class last week, bagging a double for the Sharks in last week's win. Marconi Stallions 0 – Sutherland Sharks 2 at Marconi Stallion

A Joshua Da Silva brace has helped Sutherland Sharks FC take a bite out of Marconi Stallion's top five chances, as the visitors prevailed 2-0 at Marconi Stadium on Saturday night.

It was a brilliant smash and grab result for the Sharks who held out a relentless Marconi attack and took the lead through two counter-attacking goals on either side of the interval.

The Stallions were reduced to 10 men after 38 minutes when Sean O'Connell was sent off but it didn't stop them dominating the fixture.

However, it proved to be little consolation for the Peter Tsekenis coached side who suffered yet another frustrating defeat when the result could've easily gone the other way.



Blacktown City 1 – Sydney FC 0 at Lily Homes Stadium

Blacktown City claimed a third win in a row after Danny Choi's second half strike saw off Sydney FC 1-0 in their clash at Lily's Football Stadium on Saturday evening.

Choi guided in his first goal of the season four minutes after the half time interval to settle any simmering nerves around Seven Hills and ultimately defeat the visiting Sky Blues who had impressively gone toe to toe with the competition heavyweights throughout the contest.

Mark Crittenden's side now tighten their grip in the top three and remain two points behind leaders APIA Leichhardt Tigers following their big win over Bonnyrigg on Saturday evening, with second placed Sydney Olympic set to face Wollongong Wolves later on Sunday afternoon.

The win is also Blacktown's first shutout in five matches and despite Crittenden's men lacking a degree of sharpness in the final third, City will take plenty of positives from a defensive standpoint particularly after a run of matches that has seen the side lose twice to Marconi Stallions and Sydney Olympic and concede five goals in their last two.

Sutherland Sharks will face the sternest test of their title defence so far when second-placed Blacktown City travel to Seymour Shaw on Saturday afternoon.

Aside from a shock 2-1 defeat to Sydney Olympic last fortnight the defending champions have swept all before them in the campaign's first half and will be looking to enter the second half of the season with a statement victory at home.

Nick Dimovski's side boast an immense range of attacking talent across the roster but James Temelkovski and Deren O'Brien (seven and five goals respectively) have emerged as key men for the Sharks and will need to be guarded carefully by the visiting Blacktown.

City prepared for their biggest match of the season by drawing 4-4 with fellow championship contenders Sydney FC last Saturday in a result that both highlighted the offensive potential of the side but also a lack of pragmatism after squandering a two-goal advantage in the final 10 minutes. John Carnevale's men will have been well drilled for the challenge of Sutherland during the week and should be hugely motivated to claim a game-changing victory ahead of the last 11 rounds.
