



1ST GRADE MATCH PREVIEW

Clinging onto their spot inside the top five, Sutherland Sharks will be determined to consolidate their chance at finals football with a win when they host Rockdale City Suns on Saturday in what will be a fiery derby.

Sutherland are currently fifth in the standings, ahead of Wollongong only on goal difference.

Last week Grant Lee's side suffered a 2-1 loss at their Seymour Shaw home ground to Blacktown City.

Their opponents Rockdale City Suns were also on the wrong side of a losing scoreline as they went down 2-0 to bottom side Sydney FC.

Sutherland has proven to be a solid team across the park with defender Jacob Tratt developing the Sharks defence into one of the league's toughest units.

One player that has been a little quiet after starting the year like a house on fire has been striker Adrian Vranic. The young attacker has not hit the back of the net since round 7 but will be hoping to change his fortunes by upping his scoring tally from seven for the year.

Rockdale City Suns have struggled this season being plagued with inconsistency and poor performances – this was further put to the test as they lost 2-0 to Sydney FC last Saturday further putting pressure on player/manager Paul Reid.

The Suns sit only one win off the bottom of the table despite boasting the league's third best attack not to mention some quality players at the club's disposal including Ante Covic, Blake Ricciuto, Alec Urosevski, Jordan Figon, Daniel Petkovski and Trent McClenahan to name a few.

This game will come down to discipline and which team remains mistake free.

Both sides have plenty to play for so it certainly won't be lacking excitement.

Sutherland Sharks 1 – Blacktown City 2 at Seymour Shaw

Blacktown City has held off a fast finishing Sutherland Sharks to claim a 2-1 win in their National Premier Leagues NSW Round 11 lash at Seymour Shaw on Saturday night.

Despite taking a 2-0 lead with only 20 minutes left to play, Blacktown were forced to scrap for the win in the dying stages in a match with truly lit up in an exciting second stanza.

Joey Gibbs opened the scoring for City after only twelve minutes before Danny Choi doubled the visitors lead in the 67th minute with the Sharks looking unable to match it with Mark Crittenden's well oiled side.

However, The home side found a second wind as Blair Brown pulled one back for Sutherland late on to give Blacktown a jittery final few minutes.

The final flurry proved too little too late and City's backs against the wall defence helped close out what should've been a much more straight forward victory for the Seven Hills based club.



Sydney FC has ended their 10 week winless streak with a comfortable 2-0 result against a disappointing Rockdale City Suns FC at Lambert Park on Saturday.

The Young Sky Blues were in control of the entire contest, and if not for their wastefulness could've finished the contest by half-time.

A rifled finish from Sam McIllhatton that sent Sydney FC into the break up 1-0 before Jeremy Cox confirmed the points with an arrowed finish in the second stanza to help his side fight their way off the bottom of the ladder.

Rockdale City Suns coach Paul Reid offered no excuses for his sides poor performance, despite playing three games in a short timeframe, they weren't at the races tonight and were dominated by a youthful Sky Blues side.

U20'S MATCH PREVIEW

Sutherland Sharks are aiming to extend their competition lead when struggling Rockdale City Suns come calling at Seymour Shaw on Saturday afternoon.

The Sharks currently hold a six-point advantage over nearest rivals Blacktown City, whom Sutherland comfortably beat 3-0 at home last Saturday in a performance that underlined the side's dominance of the NPL NSW Men's 20's competition in the last two years.

Outside a shock 2-1 loss at home to Sydney Olympic at the start of the month, the reigning champions have been imperious this campaign and will be brimming with confidence ahead of their clash with Rockdale.

A massive performance is required from the visitors if the Suns are to pull off an upset, but Rockdale will be bolstered by a superb comeback against third-placed Sydney FC last Saturday, in which the Suns clawed their way from two-nil down to clinch a draw with the competition heavyweights.

Rockdale should also be buoyed by their 1-1 draw with the Sharks secured back in round one, a match that saw former striker James Temelkovski net a late equalizer against the Suns to rescue a point for the 2017 champions. Temelkovski has scored seven goals in 10 appearances for Nick Dimovski's side this season.


