1ST GRADE MATCH PREVIEW

Rocked by the resignation of coach Jason Culina after a derby defeat to Bonnyrigg White Eagles, Sydney United 58 will be out to keep their season from imploding when they take on league leaders APIA Leichhardt Tigers on Saturday night.

It is the second straight season United 58 has had their coach depart after the opening weeks with the club desperate to avoid missing out on the finals as they did last season.

Responsibilities will fall on the experienced players now that Culina is gone while the club hopes that their star attack force such as Patrick Antelmi and Chris Payne start to fire with Panny Nikas gone for another week.

The club has been boosted by the return of Yianni Fragogiannis while club captain Nick Stavroulakis could be making his first grade debut for 2018 after playing two matches in the

Under 20's recovering from a pre-season injury.

Goalkeeper Tom Manos has been a rock for the club since being reinstated as the number one keeper, and once more he showed his quality, making a number of high quality saves in last weekend's loss.

Against APIA they will have an almighty challenge as Billy McColl's men enter round nine at the competition summit.

The re-emergence of Tasuku Sekiya has only strengthened an already dangerous APIA attack with the Japanese attacker set to create more opportunities for Jordan Murray, Sean Symons and George Howard.

All eyes will be on United 58 to see how they respond to the drama off the pitch.

A win against APIA would go a long way to keeping the Reds in the race for finals football.

Bonnyrigg White Eagles 2 – Sydney United 58 at Bonnyrigg Sports Club

It was derby delight for Bonnyrigg White Eagles after the snatched a 2-1 win against fierce rivals Sydney United 58 on Sunday.

It was a huge victory for the White Eagles who followed up with their second successive victory while for United 58, it was Jason Culina's second successive loss.

Ben Tosi gave the White Eagles the perfect start when he opened the scoring for the home side after 26 minutes, before Shervin Adeli strectched their lead to 2-0 midway through the second stanza.

United 58 struggled without their star playmaker Panny Nikas and claimed a mere consolation goal in the dying stages of the match as Bonnyrigg secured derby bragging rights.



APIA Leichhardt Tigers 4 – Wollongong Wolves 2 at Lambert Park

APIA Leichhardt Tigers have held on to top spot of the National Premier Leagues NSW Ladder after defeating a resilient Wollongong Wolves 4-2 at Lambert Park on Sunday afternoon.

APIA went up by two inside the first half hour thanks to goals from Tasuku Sekiya and Nathan Millgate but went into the break at 2-1 after Yuzo Tashiro pulled one back from the penalty spot for the visitors.

The game's defining moment came after the referee waved away shouts for a Wollongong penalty only for APIA striker Jordan Murray to race down the other end and make it 3-1 for the home side.

Takuya Nozawa gave Wollongong hope when he scored to make it 3-2 in the 77th minute, but a George Howard goal in the dying stages of the match clinched all three points for APIA.

U20'S MATCH PREVIEW

Sydney United 58 are looking to snap a poor run of form and return among the premiership contenders when they host APIA Leichhardt Tigers in Edensor Park on Saturday afternoon.

The Reds' 2-0 defeat to rivals Bonnyrigg White Eagles last Sunday was the fourth consecutive defeat for United 58 who started the campaign in dominant fashion but now find their position in the top five under threat.

Visitors APIA Leichhardt have endured a stopstart season so far and are yet to recapture the attacking prowess and overall form that saw the Tigers finish runners up of the competition last year.

Franco Consentino's side enter the contest in seventh position and will leapfrog their opponents on the table with a victory, making this match a crucial one for both teams.

With United 58 failing to find the back of the net in their last two matches, APIA Leichhardt might sense an opportunity to notch back to back wins for the first time this season – however their opponents will be desperate to banish their recent woes and claim a convincing win at home.
