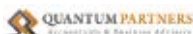

1ST GRADE MATCH PREVIEW

A gritty win last round was a big confidence booster for Hakoah Sydney City East and they will be out to add another three points to their tally on Saturday when they host Sydney Olympic FC.

The 2-0 win against Sutherland Sharks in Round 14 was a solid result for Hakoah with new striker Amaury Gauthier displaying all his class to net his second goal in three games.

The return of Andre de Jong from international duty with the New Zealand All Whites will be a massive boost for Gavin Rae's young side giving them a formidable attacking threat.

Sydney Olympic will go into the match as favourites but Hakoah are by no means easy beats and will push the league leaders for the full 90 minutes.

Hakoah Sydney City East have kept their finals hopes alive with a solid 2-0 win against Sutherland Sharks at Seymour Shaw on Saturday night.

It was a convincing performance from Hakoah with victory moving them into the top five, albeit temporarily.

Anthony Frangie opened the scoring for the visitors after 35 minutes before Amaury Gauthier wrapped up the win in the 65th minute with a cool finish.

The loss means Sutherland Sharks fall from fifth position and puts the pressure on Grant Lee's outfit..

Goals to Anthony Frangie and Amaury Gauthier for Hakoah Sydney City East settled this fixture at Seymour Shaw Park in a growing rivalry with Sutherland Sharks who lacked intensity and initiative.

However while it initially appeared that Olympic would comfortably dictate proceedings, Manly struck back in the 28th minute through Sam Wilson.

Both sides experienced periods of dominance throughout the second half, however the visitors' class eventually shone through, as they punished a wasteful Manly performance.

Hakoah Sydney City East need to bounce back from last Saturday's defeat to Sutherland Sharks when they host Sydney Olympic at Hensley Athletic Field on Saturday afternoon.

Hakoah's 2-1 defeat to Sutherland saw the side's position in the top five loosen a little further, with sixth-placed Sydney United 58 now only three points away from ousting the Eastern Sydney outfit in the finals positions.

The side will also be eager to avoid a third straight defeat – and having impressed so convincingly throughout the middle third of the campaign, another loss for Hakoah would be a bitter pill to swallow.

Visitors Sydney Olympic will be desperate to frustrate Hakoah further, and despite heading into the encounter rooted to the bottom of the table, the Blues will take confidence from their impressive 3-0 victory in round four's reverse fixture.

Time for Olympic to press their claim for a top five spot is well and truly running out with the

Blues 12 points outside the finals positions – it could be an all or nothing performance from the Belmore club on Saturday.
