Sydney United 2 – Bonnyrigg White Eagles 1 at Sydney United Sports Centre

A late Patrick Antelmi strike has helped Sydney United 58 to victory against fierce rivals Bonnyrigg White Eagles at Sydney United Sports Centre on Saturday.

Antelmi's winner stretched third placed United 58's undefeated streak to five matches and cuts the gap to second placed Sydney Olympic to only one point.

An early goal to Adrian Vlastelica had the home side in front inside the first 10 minutes.

Bonnyrigg found a way back into the match through their captain Ray Miller before substitute Patrick Antelmi found the winner in the dying stages of the game.

Hakoah Sydney City East 1 – Blacktown City FC 2 at Hensley Athletic Field

Blacktown City came from behind to earn a hard fought three points against Hakoah Sydney City with a 2-1 at Hensley Athletic Field on Saturday.

A Joey Gibbs double in as many minutes was the difference for the visitors as Hakoah once again tasted defeat after leading.

Amaury Gauthier opened the scoring for Hakoah on the cusp of halftime to give the home side a 1-0 advantage going into the interval.

However, the home side couldn't contain a relentless Blacktown attack and Gibbs netted twice in two minutes.

Hakoah tried to fight back but it was too little too late as Blacktown scooped the three competition points.

U20'S MATCH PREVIEW

Bonnyrigg White Eagles remain a mathematical chance of scraping into the finals after picking up a point against Sydney United 58 last week, but would still require both a monumental upswing in form and a miraculous set of results to go their way.

Bonnyrigg are winless since mid-June, their last victory coming in a 3-2 win over competition stragglers Rockdale in Round 15.

They'll look to pick themselves up on Saturday when they host Hakoah Sydney City East at Bonnyrigg Sports Club, where they'll be out to avenge a 1-0 defeat in the reverse of the same fixture earlier in the season.

Hakoah come into this one a week after going down 1-0 to competition leaders Blacktown City, a result that saw that saw them slip outside the five behind Wollongong Wolves on goal difference. Their final three games of the regular season appear winnable, though they can ill afford to drop points in any with several teams still hopeful of stealing into fifth.
