1ST GRADE MATCH PREVIEW

Clutching on to a finals berth, Marconi Stallions will need to hold off a dangerous Blacktown City side on Sunday.

The Stallions moved into the top five last round after a dramatic final second winner in their 2-1 victory against Hakoah Sydney City East.

It was a successful round last week for Blacktown as well with Mark Crittenden's side returning to the winners circle for the first time since May 19 as they upset league leaders Sydney Olympic 1-0 however they did need a Dakota Askew equaliser to get them across the line for a point against the Bonnyrigg White Eagles in a rescheduled round 14 fixture on Wednesday evening.

Marconi Stallions shot stopper Nenad Vekic is in for a big week this round as he takes on his former club. Vekic was a big part of the Premiership and Championship winning Blacktown sides of recent seasons and he will hope to replicate his incredible recent form

against his old teammates along with defender Peter Pelekanos who has been solid in the back alongside Michael Beauchamp.

For Blacktown look to Grant Lynch as their player to watch. In a little over one and a half seasons, Lynch has become one of the best defenders in the competition with his versatility and ability to read the game a big part of his success.

Blacktown have an enviable amount of firepower at their disposal and will look to score early and often against Marconi.

The Stallions will push Blacktown all the way in a game which is sure to feature plenty of excitement.

Hakoah Sydney City East 1 – Marconi Stallions 2 at Hensley Athletic Field

An incredible final second goal from Peter Pelekanos has given Marconi Stallions a last ditch 2-1 victory against Hakoah Sydney City East at Hensley Athletic Field.

The centre back was in the right place at the right time to find a last gasp match winner after it seemed Hakoah had done enough to claim a draw.

After a slow start to the game, Hakoah had the best of the first half chances but it was Marconi who took a 1-0 lead into the break thanks to a headed finish from former Socceroo Michael Beauchamp.

With the clock ticking down Hakoah thought they had snatched a point when Anthony Frangie hit the back of the net in the 87th minute to level the scores at 1-1.

However, there was another twist in the tale to come and Pelekanos' 93rd minute goal sent the visiting fans into raptures as they claimed an unexpected three points.

U20'S MATCH PREVIEW

Marconi's push for the finals was dealt a blow by their defeat to Sydney Olympic a fortnight ago, so it came as something of a surprise when they edged a 1-0 win over finals-bound Hakoah Sydney City East away at Hensley Athletic Field in Round 17.

The Stallions need to keep winning if they're to stand any chance of cracking the top five, and will need to rely on a huge swing in form above them from several teams. They'lll also be hoping for a far better performance against this week's opposition than last time out, when they lost 4-2 to Blacktown City at Lilys Homes Stadium.

Blacktown City's situation is rather more envious. Sitting in third behind Sutherland and Sydney FC, Blacktown could move equal first if they win their game in hand against Bonnyrigg, and come into this fixture in good form having beaten Sydney Olympic 3-1 at Belmore Sports Ground last week.
