Hakoah Sydney City East has stunned the National Premier League NSW competition with a final day 2-1 victory against APIA Leichhardt Tigers denying the Lambert Park side a second consecutive Premiership title.

The visitors took the lead in the first half before APIA pegged their opponents back with a goal from Tasuku Sekiya ten minutes after the break.

Adrian Uccchino might've won the game – and the title – for his side with a penalty but could only blast his spot kick over the crossbar.

With two minutes left on the clock, Robert Ezekiel popped up to seal a stunning win for Hakoah and deliver heartbreak for APIA and their fans.

It was an incredible result to finish the season and one which is sure to cut deep for a long time to come for the Tigers.



### Sydney Olympic 1 – Sydney United 58 0 at Belmore Sports Ground

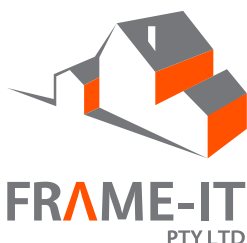
It was a dream finish for Sydney Olympic on Sunday afternoon with a 1-0 victory against Sydney United 58 securing them the 2018 National Premier Leagues NSW Men's Premiership.

Luck was on the side of the Abbas Saad coached outfit, as APIA Leichhardt Tiger's shock 2-1 loss to Hakoah Sydney City East ensured the historic club their first league premiership since 2011.

A goal to Alejandro Sanchez after only ten minutes gave the Blues the perfect start and they held on against tenacious opposition.

United 58 were reduced to 10 men on the cusp of the half time interval after Petar Markovic was sent off and had a goal disallowed for offside in the 74th.

As word travelled around the ground of APIA's defeat, Olympic's fans were building up for wild scenes at the final whistle. And what a party it was at Belmore Sports Ground.

Only last week APIA Leichhardt Tigers would've been planning to have a week off during the first week of the finals. However, the incredible results on the final day of the season which saw Sydney Olympic snatch the top spot and the Premiership has meant a shock second placed finish and face-off against Sydney United 58.

The second placed finish is sure to cut deep for APIA's players and nothing short of a Championship win will be enough.

Despite leading the competition coming into the final weeks of the season, an untimely defeat at the hands of Hakoah Sydney City East in round 22 proved fatal to Billy McColl's side.

APIA have been the pace setters this season and at times looked unbeatable with their record breaking attack scoring goals with ease.

Jordan Murray has been the focal point of APIA's attack in 2018 and the young striker's incredible return of 23 goals from 19 games has both secured him the Golden Boot award and broken the league's record for most goals in a season.

However, Murray's success has come at a cost for APIA who will need to find a new attacking focal point after their striker was signed by A-League club Central Coast Mariners.

Tasuku Sekiya, who has quietly had an impressive season himself with a return of 13 goals, will move into the number nine role left vacant by Murray's departure.

The reshuffle at APIA has opened the door for a fairytale finals series for their talismanic midfield maestro Franco Parisi.

Limited to predominately a bench role for the club in recent seasons, the gifted veteran will play a crucial role in APIA's push for Championship glory.

Their opponents United 58 have put a tumultuous start to the National Premier Leagues NSW season behind them and will be looking for a return to the Grand Final two years after their defeat in the 2016 decider.

Coach Miro Valstelica has helped the Edensor Park based side back to their best after the departure of Jason Culina as manager.

United 58 boasts a high powered midfield with an eye for goal. Wingers Patrick Antelmi and Matt Sim are a constant goal threat, while little needs to be said about star midfielder Panny Nikas.

In Round 9 Sydney United 58 claimed a hard fought 1-0 win against APIA, however it was a different story during their Round 20 match with the Tigers comprehensively thrashing The Reds 6-2 at Lambert Park

While a loss doesn't mean elimination from the finals, the prospect of a shorter passage to the grand final would be encouragement enough for both sides.

With the stakes raised, It is sure to be an edge of your seat encounter.

## U20'S MATCH PREVIEW



The NPL NSW Men's U20's dream will be over for either Sydney United 58 or Wollongong Wolves when the pair clash at Lambert Park on Saturday afternoon.

Both the Reds and the Wolves enter the elimination final needing a win to keep their chances of lifting the Championship alive.

But it is the boys from Edensor Park who arrive into the contest in buoyant mood after scraping into the top five with a win over Sydney Olympic last weekend.

That victory capped what has been a remarkable turnaround in form for United 58. The Reds' final chances were in tatters following a 7-0 drubbing at the hands of Sydney FC in round 15, but since that defeat United 58 have been among the form teams of the competition.

They've won six of their last seven games and kept clean sheets in five of these – a run that included a vital 1-0 win over Sutherland Sharks.

United 58 leapfrogged Wollongong into fourth

position on the final day, and while the Wolves have rarely slipped out of the finals spots throughout the campaign, their form entering the elimination final is patchy in contrast.

The Wolves have won just two of their last seven fixtures. They'll be hoping top scorer Tory Musumeci, who has netted 12 goals in 19 starts for the team this season, returns to the peak of his powers and is the difference between the two evenly matched sides.

Wollongong got the upper hand on their rivals with a 2-1 win back in round six, but these two teams last played out a tense 0-0 draw when they last met in round 17 and there's no doubt Saturday's do or die encounter will be similarly nervy affair.
