CLUB WELCOME

Neighbours and “arch rivals” Sydney United 58 make the short drive down Cowpasture Road tonight to Marconi Stadium for what is sure to be a “tense” battle.

Sydney United have started the season well, picking up points in all but one of the first five rounds. They are sitting in fourth place and need the win to stay in touch with the two leaders - Wollongong Wolves and APIA Leichhardt Tigers who have opened a small early lead on the premiership table (five and four points)

The Marconi Stallions with their impressive “off season recruiting” look like they are starting to click, and they were impressive 3-1 winners over Hakoah Sydney City East last round. The win has taken the

Stallions from second last to eighth, just one point outside the top five and two points behind Sydney United 58.

Veteran striker Mirjan Pavlovic looms as the danger man for the visitors – his double against Hakoah was crucial in the outcome. He’s scored three times from the five matches played so far in 2019.

Sydney United 58 scored late to beat last placed Sutherland Sharks 3-2 last round. “Tricky” Glen Trifiro scored twice and will be a key man for the visitors.

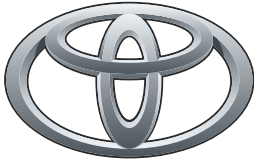
Both sides are “doubling up” from mid-week FFA Cup matches.

MATCH PREVIEW

Dubbed the original #westernsydneyderby, Marconi Stallions will be hoping their return to winning ways last week is a sign of things to come as they prepare to take on Sydney United 58 this Saturday at Marconi Stadium.

It has been a season of mixed result so far for the Stallions with only two wins from their first five matches.

Injury and inconsistent form has plagued the Peter Tsekenis coached side but they will be hoping the win against Hakoah Sydney City East last round is the kick start they needed to get their campaign back on track.

Most promising for Marconi fans is the return to form of cult favourite Mirjan Pavlovic who scored a brace in last week's 3-1 win.

The talented front man will be determined to continue his run especially after being sidelined for most of 2018 with injury.

Looking to stop Pavlovic this week will be his former club Sydney United 58.

The Reds have been strong performers this season and go into round six in fourth position with two wins and two draws from their opening five matches.

Last week United 58 snatched a last minute winner against Sutherland Sharks thanks to a Tariq Maia finish at the death.

The Miro Vlastelica coached outfit will be determined to make it back to back wins and close the gap on league leaders Wollongong.

Uruguayan import Sebastian Gallegos made his return from injury off the bench and will be looking to return to the starting line-up in coming weeks as well as another new recruit in Peter Simonoski.

Expect plenty of excitement from this clash with matches between these sides always featuring plenty of big moments.

A Mirjan Pavlovic brace has helped inspire Marconi Stallions back into the winners circle as the claimed a 3-1 National Premier Leagues NSW Men's win against Hakoah Sydney City at Marconi Stadium on Sunday.

Pavlovic found the back of the net each side of the interval as his Marconi Side secured only their second win of the 2019 season.

The veteran striker notched his first after 16 minutes to give the Stallions the perfect start but Hakoah's Shohei Okhuno equalised for the visitors sending both sides into the break deadlocked at one apiece.

Marconi lifted their game in the second stanza with Marko Jescic scoring only moments after the restart before Pavlovic wrapped up the result by scoring his second of the night.

The talented midfielder delivered at the death with a clinical finish to give United 58 a return to winning ways.

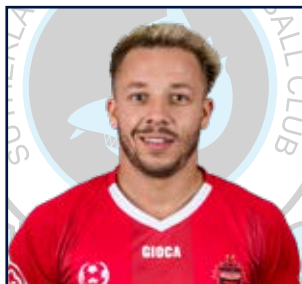
