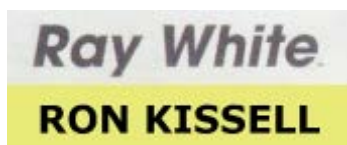

MATCH PREVIEW

Three losses from their first four games is not the way Sutherland Sharks would've wanted to start their season but they will have a chance to make amends when they host Sydney United 58 at Seymour Shaw on Saturday.

A narrow 1-0 loss to Blacktown City in round four was another painful defeat for the Terry Palapanis coached side.

Despite their poor results, Sutherland have shown plenty of potential and should've come away with much more from their past three matches.

Against Blacktown City last Sunday, new recruit Caoimhin Fowler and Lachlan Everett stole the show and were unlucky not to find the back of the net with their attacking displays.

Momentary lapses have proved costly for the Sharks and if they can keep it together will be a good chance of snapping their losing streak.

United 58 come into the game off the back of defeat as well with the Reds suffering a 3-1 loss to APIA Leichhardt Tigers last week.

It was their first defeat of the season as they were undone by their former star striker, now playing for APIA, Chris Payne.

Injuries to Petar Markovic and Patrick Antelmi will give coach Miro Vlastelica plenty to ponder going into this weekend's match.

The Reds are hoping that their Uruguayan star Sebastián Gallegos could be ready to go this Saturday after an injury lay-off in pre-season.

United 58 will be the favourites for this clash but Sutherland have the players to cause an upset as they did so against 2018 Premiers and Champions Sydney Olympic in round 1.

Blacktown City 1 – Sutherland Sharks 0 at Lily Homes Stadium

A second half Leroy Jennings goal has helped lift Blacktown City snatch a hard fought 1-0 win against Sutherland Sharks in their National Premier Leagues NSW Men's clash at Lily Homes Stadium on Sunday.

Jennings made the most of a breakaway run from Joey Gibbs to tap in from close range at the far post to claim the match winner.

It was the sort of clinical finishing required in a match which at times struggled to excite with quality chances at a premium.

The win keeps Blacktown in the finals places while Sutherland suffer a frustrating defeat for the second straight week.



Sydney United 58 1 – APIA Leichhardt Tigers 3 at Sydney United Sports Centre

A sensational Chris Payne hat-trick has buried his former side Sydney United 58 as APIA Leichhardt claimed a 3-1 win in a blockbuster National Premier Leagues NSW Men's clash at Sydney United Sports Centre on Sunday.

It was a fairytale return to the ground where Payne called home for three seasons with the veteran front man delivering a striking masterclass in front of his former fans.

An absolute screamer on the bounce from an Ivan Necevski goal kick opened Payne's account on the cusp of half time.

United 58 levelled the score thanks to some clinical finishing from Patrick Antelmi but it was Payne's day with the former A-League striker finishing off a sublime Franco Parisi assist to give APIA a 2-1 lead in the 68th minute.

Payne wrapped up the result, and his hat-trick, in the dying stages of the match when he converted from the penalty spot to condemn United 58 to their first defeat of the season.



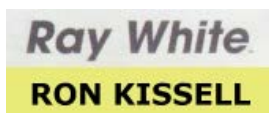
Sutherland Sharks have started the 2019 season slowly and will be desperate to make up lost ground when they host Sydney United 58 on Saturday afternoon.
