MATCH PREVIEW

An old rivalry is set to reignite when Rockdale City Suns host Sydney United 58 at Ilinden Sports Centre on Sunday.

These two sides have a history of heated encounters and with only two points separating them at the top end of the ladder it is sure to be more of the same this time around.

Rockdale City Suns snatched a hard fought 1-1 draw last round against a much improved Sutherland Sharks outfit but are sure to view the result as an opportunity lost against a side much lower than them on the table.

While the Suns winning streak may have come to an end, they are still unbeaten in their last six league matches and won't want to give up their incredible record against their rivals.

Interim coach Nick Porecca will be buoyed by the team's shrinking injury list with the squad slowly returning to full strength for the second half of the campaign. Porecca's latest string of wins could potentially spearhead the committee to gift him a full-time contract due to his change of fortunes since the Suns parted ways with Paul Reid.

Brayden Sorge was the latest player to make a return

to the match day squad which is set to make it a real battle for positions in Porecca's starting team.

Sydney United 58 come into the contest with their tail between their legs after a humiliating 3-0 loss to Manly United.

It was a tough day at the office for the Miro Vlastelica coached side with nothing falling the way of the Reds at Cromer Park in round 11.

However, very few things can fire up a team the way a derby match can so expect United 58 to bounce back in a big way.

Vlastelica had all three of his big name attacking players in Matthew Sim, Peter Simonoski and Patrick Antelmi in the starting line-up against Manly so it will be interesting to see if he goes with a similar attack against the Suns or whether he tinkers with his line-up once more.

In round one, this match was a scoreless stalemate.

Don't expect that to happen this time around.

Rockdale City Suns will be the favourites at home in front of what will be a big crowd, but this game is sure to feature plenty of fireworks so anything could happen.

It was a frustrating result as well for Rockdale as they missed the chance to move into top spot with a win.



Manly United FC 3 – Sydney United 0 at Cromer Park

Manly United cruised to a comfortable 3-0 victory over Sydney United 58 at Cromer Park on Sunday afternoon.

First-half strikes from flying wingers Charles Mendy and Adam Parkhouse gave the hosts some breathing space at the interval, before Brendan Cholakian sealed the deal with ten minutes to play.

A stubborn defensive effort from Paul Dee's men saw the formidable firepower in United 58's lineup restricted to half-chances for the majority of the ninety.

The result, Manly's first victory in three and United 58's first defeat in five, leaves both sides positioned narrowly inside the all-important top five at the mid-way point of the 2019 National Premier League NSW Men's season.
