
































MATCH PREVIEW

Second place on the ladder goes on the line this Sunday at Lambert Park as APIA Leichhardt Tigers play host to rivals Sydney United 58.

APIA haven't won in three weeks and the pressure is mounting on John Calleja's side as the trailing pack close in.

A shock 2-2 draw last week against Sutherland Sharks, despite leading 2-0 early in the match, is sure to cut deep with the Tigers and it wouldn't be too much to assume they'd want to give it everything to return to the winners circle this week.

The game is also set to have another interesting storyline with new APIA acquisition Nick Stavroulakis to face his former side only two weeks after the club stated he was not in their plans.

Stavroulakis made his debut for APIA last week and will no doubt play as a key player in the big match on Sunday along with club stalwart Franco Parisi.

The back-line of Themba Muata Marlow and Josh Symons as well as Paul Galimi, who have formed a formidable defence line, will know they will be up for a huge match come Sunday.

The last time these two sides met it was an incredible performance from Chris Payne, who also made the move from United 58 to APIA this season, with the veteran striker scoring a brilliant hat-trick.

He will likely carry much of the attacking burden again this time around.

United 58 come into this game riding high on confidence after claiming a 2-1 upset away from home against league leaders Wollongong Wolves.

The win will have visiting team brimming with confidence and determined to take down another high profile opponent.

Matt Sim was the main destroyer last week and his ability to create and finish chances will again be a major weapon for the Reds.

This match has plenty riding on it and these teams have history so expect nothing less than a blockbuster on Sunday.

APIA Leichhardt Tigers 2 – Sutherland Sharks 2 at Lambert Park

APIA Leichhardt's Premiership hopes took a major blow at Lambert Park on Saturday as they we held to a 2-2 draw by a resurgent Sutherland Sharks.

Up 2-0 inside twenty minutes, the Tigers blew their lead to slip to a disappointing draw at home.

Chris Payne scored from the spot soon after kickoff before Tynan Diaz added a second barely ten minutes later, but Dominic Cox and Charles Lokolingoy were on hand to help Sutherland storm back in the second half.

After Wollongong's loss to Sydney Olympic earlier in the afternoon, APIA might have finished the round within three points of the leaders, but instead sit five points off top spot – and with a few challengers behind them.



Wollongong Wolves 1 – Sydney United 58 2 at WIN Stadium Wollongong

A stoppage-time strike from Matthew Sim helped Sydney United 58 take all three points from league-leading Wollongong Wolves in a 2-1 victory at WIN Stadium on Sunday afternoon.

Sim scored in the final moments of the fiery clash – which saw nine yellow cards and the dismissal of Sydney United 58's Patrick Antelmi – to secure the win for the visitors after Tariq Maia's first half strike was cancelled out by Wollongong's Thomas James.

It was a massive result for Sydney United who join Blacktown City and APIA Leichhardt Tigers in a three way tie for second spot.

Wollongong cling onto first place but they now only hold a six point advantage ahead of the chasing pack.

U20'S MATCH PREVIEW

APIA Leichhardt start Round 15 in second place after a 2-0 win over Sutherland Sharks took them three points clear of third-placed Sydney FC – though they remain nine points behind leaders Blacktown City.

Michael Trajkovski scored both goals for APIA as they won consecutive matches for the first time since the opening fortnight of the season, a run they should be confident of stretching into a third week as they prepare to welcome Sydney United to Lambert Park.

The visitors are four points adrift at the bottom of the table ahead of Sunday afternoon's match, having lost 3-0 to Wollongong Wolves in Round 14.

After going three matches without a defeat in May, Sydney United have now lost their last two matches while the teams directly above them continue to pick up points. They can only hope for a repeat of their Round 4 clash with APIA, a 1-0 win which accounts for one of their two victories in 2019.
