MATCH PREVIEW

A resurgent Mt Druitt Town Rangers will be hoping to make it four wins on the trot with an upset victory against competition front runners Wollongong Wolves at Popondetta Park on Saturday night.

They've been one of the form side's of the competition and one not too many of the top five teams would want to face come the latter stages of the competition.

The Rangers have been in inspired form in June with three wins and a draw from their past four matches to move only three points outside of the top five.

However, the Aidan Desmond coached side will face a major test against the Wolves who have lost only two games this season and hold a five point lead over second place.

A mid-season reshuffle has been a big part of Mt Druitt's recent success with the acquisition of strikers Mirijan Pavlovic and John Roberts helping kick start the Rangers late season run.

The form of Uruguayan Fabricio Fernandez has also played a major role and his hat-trick last week against Sydney FC was his best performance of the season.

Expect Desmond to give the trio of Pavlovic, Roberts and Fernandez plenty of opportunities to take over the match and challenge a disciplined Wollongong defence.

The Wolves come into the match after defeating Sydney Olympic 2-0 to notch their 11th win of the season

After years of failing to live up to their potential, Wollongong has finally delivered and it's taken a rebuild from former Socceroos defender Luke Wilkshire to achieve the highs their fans have been craving for years.

The goalscoring of English striker Thomas James has been a big part of their success this season, but last week former Wanderers striker Lachlan Scott chipped in with a brace to prove the Wolves attack is far from one dimensional.

Wollongong's defence shouldn't go unnoticed either with the unit led by Nick Littler and Nikola Djordjevic along with Taylor McDonald helping their side concede less than a goal a game so far this campaign.

The two defeats suffered by the Wolves this season have been at home with the side maintaining a perfect record on the road.

Saturday's match against a very much in-form Mt Druitt team could end that record if Wilkshire's Wolves outfit don't come prepared for a battle.

Wollongong will be the favourites but if the Rangers last three matches are any to go by, their new attacking trio could prove game changers yet again.

However, it was Fernandez's match as he wrapped up the win for Mt Druitt, and his hat-trick, with a cool finish eight minutes out from full-time.

A brace from Wollongong's Lachlan Scott was enough to return the Wolves to the National Premier League NSW Men's winner's circle on Sunday afternoon, with the side prevailing 2-0 over Sydney Olympic at WIN Stadium.

The former Western Sydney Wanderers front man scored the only goals of the match, nabbing a pair of second half goals to maintain Wollongong's five-point lead at the top of the table.

Olympic had their chances to draw level but fluffed their lines as they slumped to another frustrating defeat.
