MATCH PREVIEW

Sydney FC will be out to end a three game skid when they host an in-form Mt Druitt Town Rangers side on Saturday night at Lambert Park.

Jimmy van Weeren's side has slumped to defeat in their last three games and will be hoping a return home will help them in their battle to avoid relegation.

What's even more concerning for the Young Sky Blues has been how poor they have been defensively over the past three matches conceding 12 goals while only scoring three.

The loss of key players Liam McGing and Jerry Skotadis is sure to have had a major impact on Sydney FC's structure in both midfield and defence.

Against Wollongong in Round 15, Sydney held strong against the league's best attack during the first half but fell away in the second stanza.

Van Weeren will be pushing his players at training this week so they can go the full 90 minutes against Mt Druitt.

FC's rising young keeper Thomas Heward-Belle has no doubt played a role in keeping the Sky Blues at bay and will need to be at his best on Saturday.

The Rangers come into this game with back to back

wins and have been unbeaten from their last three matches.

It has been a rapid turnaround for the Popondetta Park based side who have struggled at times this campaign to match it with the competition's top teams.

Mt Druitt has been active in the transfer market and it appears to have given the team a new vigour.

Last week's 2-0 upset of Rockdale City Suns was evidence of this and coach Aiden Desmond will be hoping his side can make it a treble of wins against Sydney.

Fabricio Fernandez and John Roberts were the goal scorers last week with the former Wanderer's striker helping give the Uruguayan midfielder a new lease on life.

Mt Druitt can be a formidable attacking force on it's day so Sydney will need to be at their best.

The departure of Rangers captain Matthew Clowes hasn't had as big of an impact as fans anticipated but the midfield will face a challenging test this week against a young and energetic opponent.

Mt Druitt will hold the title of favourite coming into this contest but It very well could go either way.



U20'S MATCH PREVIEW

Jaiden Kucharski scored twice at Win Stadium to give Sydney FC a 2-1 win over Wollongong Wolves last weekend, a result which kept the Sky Blues level with APIA and Rockdale behind Blacktown City, but in second place on goal difference.

Sydney FC have lost just once in their last nine matches and will be eager to keep that run going ahead of a clash against Blacktown City looming in Round 17. This week they welcome Mt Druitt to Lambert Park, with the Rangers travelling east following an extraordinary 7-5 loss to Rockdale last Saturday.

Jordan Gomez scored a hattrick for his side but it wasn't enough as Mt Druitt fell behind, equalised, then went in front before conceding three goals in the last fifteen minutes of the match.

Mt Druitt's last win came six weeks ago at this same ground, when they defeated APIA Leichhardt 1-0 courtesy of an own-goal from the hosts. The Rangers currently sit six points adrift of fifth-placed Sutherland Sharks.
