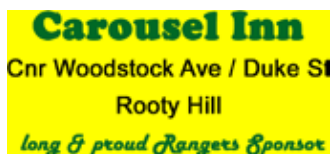

MATCH PREVIEW

Mt Druitt Town Rangers have a chance of an incredible finals berth in their first season in the NPL NSW but first they must defeat APIA Leichhardt Tigers.

The Rangers have found their groove over the second half of the campaign and could sneak into fifth spot with a win and if other results go their way.

Last week Mt Druitt cruised to a dominant 4-0 win against Hakoah Sydney City East but APIA will be a far tougher task.

The Aidan Desmond coached side boast a quality attack with plenty of scoring options including John Roberts, Mirjan Pavlovic and Toufic Alameddine.

Pulling the strings is Fabricio Fernandez who is just as likely to score as he is to create goals.

APIA's defence will need to be up to their best for this match but they haven't earned their second spot on the table without knowing how to stop the opposition from scoring.

With their spot on the table secured as well as finals football APIA have the possibility of rotating their squad to freshen their legs ahead of the post season.

Don't be surprised if coach John Calleja calls on some of his younger players for this match. With a couple of players walking the tight rope with yellow cards, some fresh new faces could be seen as well as the

introduction of Nick Stavroulakis who may return.

Striker Chris Payne will be looking to add to his tally of 20 goals as the race for the golden boot goes down to the wire. Since moving from Sydney United 58 where he was let go, Payne has relished his time at the Tigers and has been on fire in front of goals.

Mt Druitt have a lot riding on this match and will be tough to beat at home. If APIA go with a full strength squad they will be favourites but if not the result could be wide open.

Alex Boyadjian and Toufic Alameddine scored in the first half hour to give the Rangers a lead 2-0 at the break.

Alameddine completed his brace in the second half alongside a Jacob Esposito goal to bank three more points in their maiden season in the NSW top flight.

For Hakoah Sydney City East, the visitors had their chances through Amauri Gauthier and Joshua Swadling but were wasteful in front of goal. The relegated side added a missed penalty in the second half as they look to next week to finish on a high.

Manly United 0 – APIA Leichhardt Tigers 1 at Cromer Park

APIA Leichhardt Tigers laboured their way to a tight 1-0 triumph over a spirited Manly United outfit at Cromer Park on Sunday afternoon.

Despite only bearing a solitary goal, the Northern Beaches crowd were treated to an entertaining affair where both sides retained position well and experienced periods of domination.

In the end, they were split by a second-half Chris Payne strike which brought up 20 goals for the former Manly striker this campaign.

The result all but sealed second spot for APIA, whilst striking one last dagger in the heart of Manly's fading finals aspirations.

U20'S MATCH PREVIEW

APIA Leichhardt travel to Popondetta Park on Sunday afternoon with their fate out of their hands, having lost the advantage in the race for second or third behind Blacktown City after a 2-1 defeat to Manly United last weekend.

APIA lost for the first time in four weeks at Cromer Park last weekend, with Zeke Prisuda scoring the only goal for the Tigers as they settled into fifth place behind Sydney FC and Rockdale.

They could yet beat Rockdale into third, but would need to win here while hoping Sutherland win at

Ilinden Sports Centre.

Mt Druitt, for their part, fell to a disappointing 2-1 defeat to Hakoah Sydney City East in Round 21; Riley Ellem scoring his side's only goal as the Rangers ended the match with ten men following Emmanuel Peters' red card.

Mt Druitt could finish as high as ninth should they beat APIA and other results go their way, though the Tigers will make for a determined opponent as they look to avoid an elimination final next week.
