CLUB WELCOME

The Board of Directors at Club Marconi warmly welcome Sydney FC to our "Palace" for the start of the 2021 NPL NSW Men's Season.

As part of the "Football Family" we are all hoping for a more "normal" season given the extreme difficulties faced by all Australians both "on and off" the field in 2020.

Marconi Stallions FC Coach Peter Tsekenis has maintained the bulk of his squad. He has added some "firepower" going forward with the acquisitions of former Dandenong Thunder (Victoria) attacker Chris Hatfield and youthful former West Sydney Wanderers attacker Stefan Nikolic. The 17-year-old is ear marked for big things – he has the ability and aspirations to play abroad in the future.

The youngster has joined at late notice after "key signing" Charles Lokolingoy was "snapped up" by A-League Club Wellington Phoenix. The big striker looked a great fit in pre-season matches and will be missed – he played as a replacement for the Phoenix in their drawn match last weekend against Western Sydney Wanderers.

Tsekenis has also added two youngsters from the U2O squad – Mason Ingram and Paolo Laxamana. Both have had a taste of senior football in the last two seasons

The Stallions are well prepared having played nine trial matches, the most recent in Canberra against Monaro Panthers.

The coach is comfortable with where his squad is at. "We have kept the core of the squad which is really important for team cohesion. I am really looking forward to giving this season a real big shake." he added.

"Sydney FC always have good talent so we know what we will be up against."

The youthful Sydney City FC under Jimmy Van Weeren will be a difficult task first up.

Their squad is identical to last season, they are aiming at a first time run into the final series. In last season's reduced competition they finished fifth, just missing the semi-finals.

"All of our Sydney FC squad are either retained or promoted from younger age groups within the Academy Program" according to coach Van Weeren.

They are aiming to be competitive in every match this season.

Sydney FC has managed to retain key players including NPL NSW Men's competition top goal scorer Patrick Wood who finished with 11 goals in 2020, as well as Jordi Swibel, Callum Talbot and Calem Nieuwhenhof, all of which have made first team appearances in Steve Corica's A-League side this year.

Both sides will be keen to start the season on a winning note.

At half time in NPL matches played at Marconi Stadium Under 6/7/8 teams from surrounding clubs will play in the Markka Cup.

It is a club initiative aimed at putting the youngest players on centre stage during the season. It will start in the coming weeks once competing clubs are known.


Football in NSW is one tight knit community, we are here to help each other no matter what the result is.
