

MATCH PREVIEW

The Mt Druitt Town Rangers will be looking for a win in their first home game of the season when they host APIA Leichhardt at Popondetta Park on Saturday.

The Stewart Montgomery coached side were forced to settle for a point in week one after they conceded a dramatic equaliser in the dying seconds of their clash with Manly United.

A big talking point going into this match will be the status of Rangers star recruit Tarek Elrich who went down injured only 13 minutes into last week's game.

John Roberts and Blake Thompson were stand out performers in the Round 1 clash and hope to back up with another big showing against APIA.

Looking to ruin Mt Druitt's coming home party will be APIA Leichhardt making their second trip to western Sydney in as many weeks.

APIA was held to a scoreless draw in round one, but coach John Calleja will have plenty to smile after an impressive defensive display.

Josh Symons was named to the round one team of the week after nullifying a potent Blacktown attack and will be up for another big showing. Harry Callahan delivered an impressive cameo performance off the bench and should be pushing for a starting berth while we may see the debut of former Western Sydney Wanderers high flyer Mathieu Cordier.

Mt Druitt has been touted as a dark horse this season and will need a win against a competition powerhouse such as APIA to prove their case as a team to watch truly.

FIRST GRADE REVIEWS

The National Premier Leagues NSW competition is back and it was all action during a thrilling opening round.

Rockdale Ilinden finished the 2020 regular season in first place and will maintain that mantle to start the season with a big win to kick start the new campaign.

Sydney FC and Sydney United 58 also took home three points from their matches as the only other winners from this weekend's fixtures.

APIA Leichhardt and Blacktown City shared the spoils in their clash on Saturday, while the Sutherland Sharks marked their return to the competition with a dramatic 2-2 draw against Northbridge Bulls.

All matches throughout the opening round paid tribute to former Rockdale midfielder Idriss El Hafiane who passed away earlier this year.

Manly United 1 – Mt Druitt Town Rangers 1 at Cromer Park

The National Premier Leagues NSW Men's returned in style on Friday night as a spectacular header from Manly United's Seiya Kambayashi broke Mount Druitt Town Ranger's resolve to seal a 1-1 draw deep into stoppage time at Cromer Park.

Sydney's Northern Beaches played host to the competition's opening fixture which kicked off in frenetic fashion, as both sides traded blows early on.

Mt Druitt opened the scoring early in the second half through John Roberts and looked to be on track to take home all three points.

However, Manly had other ideas as Kambayashi nodded home in the 92nd minute to secure a draw in dramatic fashion.

It was a bitter pill to swallow for the Rangers who also lost star recruit Tarek Elrich to injury only 15 minutes into the contest.

Blacktown City 0 – APIA Leichhardt FC 0 at Lily Homes Stadium

Blacktown City FC and APIA Leichardt Tigers shared the points after a scoreless draw in their Round 1 clash at Lily Holmes Stadium on Saturday night

While both teams put on threatening attacking displays during the 90-minute battle, it was the defence of both teams that showed that they are teams to be reckoned with in the 2021 New South Wales National Premier Leagues Men's season.

Travis Major was unlucky not to score in a brilliant performance on his return to Blacktown.

APIA will be happy to take a point away from a difficult contest which very easily could've gone the way of the home side.
