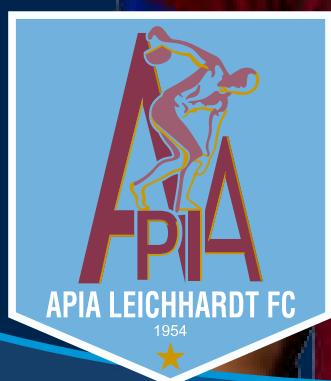

## FROM THE COACH

### A Message from APIA'S Head Coach - Paul Dee

## MATCH PREVIEW

APIA Leichhardt will be battling for back to back wins for the first time this season when they host Wollongong Wolves at Lambert Park on Friday night.

Midfield maestro Franco Parisi led the side to a 3-2 win against Sydney FC in Round 8 with a brace which helped the side climb off the bottom of the table.

Coach Paul Dee will be hoping it is the start of a change in fortunes for his APIA side, which has struggled to live up to their potential.

The return of Paul Galimi from injury in recent weeks has given the Leichhardt based side some much-needed steel in defence, while the midfield is starting to find their rhythm.

Skipper Sean Symons started up-front for APIA and we could well see him there again should Blake Powell not recover in time from injury while the return from suspension of David D'Apuzzo will certainly add more steel to the squad although the former A-League player will be sidelined through injury following the club's FFA Cup match against Connells Point Rovers last week.

They will be up against a Wollongong Wolves side who are also desperate to get their season back on track.

The Luke Wilkshire coached outfit come into this game on the back of a 5-0 thrashing at home to Blacktown city.

After keeping a clean sheet in their previous two matches, the round eight defeat was a major regression for the Wolves, who sit only one point ahead of APIA on the competition ladder.

They will be without young attacker Marcus Beattie for this clash after he was sent off against Blacktown. Simultaneously, there are questions marks around the availability of veteran defender Darcy Madden after he was forced off through injury less than 20 minutes into last week's match.

Lachlan Scott is the man that will carry the burden of delivering for the visitors at Lambert on Friday.

This is a tightly placed contest with both teams in desperate need of three competition points.
