MATCH PREVIEW

Mt Druitt Town Rangers will be desperate to turn their early-season struggles around when they play Sydney Olympic at Popondetta Park on Saturday.

A 4-1 loss albeit with ten-men to Sutherland Sharks was the latest blow to the Rangers season so far, with coach Stewart Montgomery searching for answers.

Mt Druitt is desperate to fight their way out of their slump and will be up for a big game against Olympic.

Suspensions will force a bit of a reshuffle this week for Montgomery, with Solomon-Johnn Monohan-Vaiika to miss this match after seeing red against the Sharks.

Looking to stop them is a Sydney Olympic side looking for its third straight victory.

The Ante Juric coached outfit seems to have found its rhythm after a slow start to the campaign.

Ben van Meurs and Jason Madonis were on the scoresheet last round, but Juric will still want to see more scoring from his big-name attacking players.

Adam Parkhouse had his best game so far this season, and the speedster will be one to watch against a Rangers defence that has leaked goals in recent weeks.

Olympic will be favourites despite being on the road; however, the Rangers won't be giving up without a fight.

Mt Druitt made a fast start to the contest with Jack Stewart finding the back of the net after only 16 minutes to give the visitors a 1-0 lead.

However, it would all be all downhill from there for the Rangers with Andrew netting an equaliser and then Solomon-Johnn Monohan-Vaiika sent off before the interval.

Andrew scored two more after the interval and Jeremy Cox also got in on the act as Sutherland clinched all three points in style.
