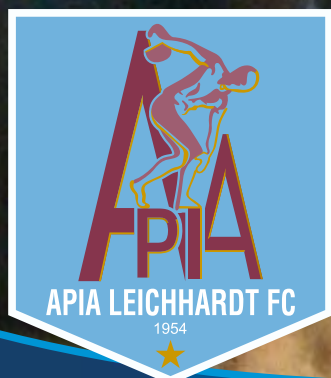

The Club and private benefactors, and other sources, in cash, contra, and in-kind, contributed a further \$1.4m.

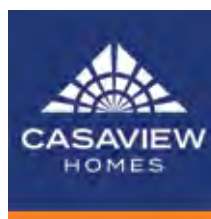



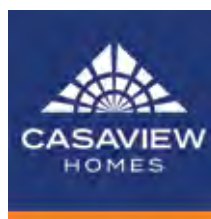

FROM THE COACH

A Message from APIA'S Head Coach - Paul Dee



A big game this week against competition leaders in Blacktown City who have been in great form throughout the first half of the season, boasting the best attacking record of all teams. Blacktown are always a tough team to play – they are very well coached and possess a great balance of pace, skill and experience in their playing group. Blacktown have enormous attacking firepower in the likes of Travis Major, Charles Mendy and Mario Shabow, but are also well marshalled in defence with senior players like Matt Lewis and Grant Lynch organising the structure in the back third. Blacktown are always fully committed in their performance, and I expect nothing different this week, it will be an extremely competitive game.

Our squad unfortunately is coming off a disappointing 3-2 loss after a tough game against Sydney United. Despite fighting back twice throughout the game to level scores and having a lot of momentum in the second half, we conceded a goal in the last minute of the game courtesy of a deflected free kick. Playing at Lambert Park is not easy for any opponent and we will be looking to continue that through an attacking brand of football from APIA and applying a high amount of pressure in defence. Considering so far this year Blacktown have been the benchmark, this is an important game and achieving a win against them would be a terrific result.

Coach Mark Crittenden knows how to get the most out of his squad and will be pushing them towards a fifth straight win and a tighter grip on first place.

Blacktown will be favourites for this clash, however, if APIA wants to prove themselves as finals contenders an upset in this match is the perfect place to start.

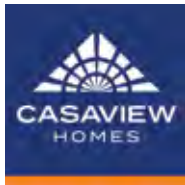

THE ANNUAL VIAREGGIO COPPA CARNEVALE WORLD YOUTH TOURNAMENT

APIA has been a participant in this prestigious World Class Tournament for nearly two decades rubbing shoulders with the likes of the mighty Juventus, A C Milan (the two most successful Clubs in this Tournament with nine titles each), as well as Manchester United and Inter Milan, to name a few.

The Viareggio Tournament, officially named the Viareggio Cup World Football Tournament Coppa Carnevale, is a youth association football tournament held annually in Viareggio, Italy and its surrounding areas. Established in 1949, the Torneo di Viareggio is considered one of the most important youth football tournaments in the world.

It coincides with the Carnival of Viareggio, starting on the third Monday of Carneval. The tournament runs for a fortnight, and finishes on the last Monday of the Carnival. For this reason, it is also known as the Coppa Carnevale (Carnival Cup).
