

Elevated pitch a southern-hemisphere first

ONE of Australia's most famous soccer clubs is lobbying state and federal governments for \$35 million in funding to build a boutique stadium in Sydney inner west.

It would be the first of its kind in the southern hemisphere in that architects have designed the complex with training fields on ground level and the main synthetic-grass pitch to be built on mega-concrete pylons.

The existing playing surface at Lambert Park in Leichhardt would become four international-standard playing courts underneath the new playing field for basketball, indoor cricket and other sports. The existing

surface is already bigger than all European soccer clubs and is the most utilised sporting facility in the inner west.

It is interesting that Apia Leichhardt is sponsored by Wests Ashfield, the majority shareholder of Wests Tigers in

If approved, the stadium and complex would no doubt


attract huge interest from the NRL in its own lobbying of the government to build bigger multi-purpose boutique stadiums and high-performance facilities in suburban areas.

Apia Leichhardt plays in the National Premier League, the competition below the A-League. The club has produced more Socceroos than any

other in Australia including former World Cup skipper Peter Wilson.

The new stadium would have 6000 grandstand seats and hold a crowd of almost 10,000.

Apia is attempting to break the NPL attendance record next Sunday when it hosts traditional rivals Sydney Olympic at the venue.


Having both played midweek catch up games their fitness will likely play a major part in the result.
