MATCH PREVIEW

Marconi will come up against APIA Leichhardt for the second Italian Derby in two weeks.

This time around Marconi will have the homeground advantage as they host their rivals at 'The Palace' on Saturday evening.

The Marconi faithful will relish the opportunity to settle the score against the Inner West side, with both teams having won one of their matchups this season - Marconi with a 4-1 victory in Round 10, and APIA with a 2-0 victory in Round 21.

After defender Roberto Speranza was sent off in the Round 20 clash between the two, he will sit out this one, while his replacement Zach Cairncross left the field in Round 22 with a hamstring injury, leaving his selection in doubt.

If Cairncross isn't fit to play in the Elimination Semi-Final, Stallions coach Peter Tsekenis will have to lean on his team to play out of their preferred position.

With three goals from players outside their usual goal scorers in their last match, Marconi will have some extra confidence and momentum, especially since losing attacker Charles Lokolingoy.

APIA Leichhardt's defeat to Sydney United 58 in Round 21 will have them hungry to bounce back from disappointment, and a high-intensity clash might be exactly what they need to bring out the best in their squad.

With plenty of experience on the park from goalkeeper Ivan Necevski, captain Adrian Ucchino, the Symons brothers and Franco Parisi, APIA know the importance of this match having been in three of the last four grand finals.

Their only win from the last eight games was against Marconi, so while they haven't been in the best form heading into the finals, they'll know they're capable of coming out on top in the match.

It's do-or-die for both teams as they must win to continue their finals campaign, so who will go through to the Minor Semi-Final?

The Marconi Stallions secured a spot in next weekend's do or die elimination final against old foes APIA Leichhardt after defeating the Northbridge Bulls 3-1 at the Sydney United Sports Centre on Sunday.

The energetic Bulls opened scoring in the 14th minute through Stephan De Robillard, but Marconi were quick to respond with Nathan Millgate equalising in the 16th minute.

The Stallions then took the lead in the 68th minute through Brandon Vella and topped it off with a goal to substitute Martin Fernandez in the 2nd minute of injury time.

The win sees Marconi progress through to the finals in fourth position on the ladder, giving them one chance to move forward in the series, while Northbridge's season has officially come to a close.




