MATCH PREVIEW

In the fight to secure the final spot in the National Premier Leagues NSW Men's Grand Final, Sydney Olympic will take on Blacktown City FC.

In a rematch of the final match of the season that saw Sydney Olympic crowned Premiers after defeating Blacktown City, who would have secured the premiership if they held on for a draw or a win, the two heavyweights will come face to face as they look to join Manly United FC in the Grand Final.

After taking out the silverware, Olympic enjoyed a week off before matching up with Manly United last weekend, where they suffered a loss in a tight penalty shootout.

They will surely be fired up and looking for redemption in front of their home fans as they hunt down the double glory in the 2022 competition.

Having already secured the win over the Western Sydney side in Round 11 and the victory in Round 22, Olympic will be confident they can tackle Blacktown as they have already proved twice this year.

Golden boot winner Roy O'Donovan will be one to watch as he leads the attacking force of Olympic, alongside their other talented attackers, with the likes of Oliver Pufflet, Adam Parkhouse and Darcy Burgess all posing big threats.

Sam McIlhatton secured the only goal within the match last week and will be looking to make it two from two, while the defensive duo of Michael Glascock and Ben Van Meurs will be hoping to hold out Blacktown.

Travis Major has been a force to be reckoned with since rejoining Blacktown late in the season, while Mitchell Mallia and Jordan Smylie were the goal scorers in last week's win.

The Blacktown defence has been an impressive source of strength

throughout the whole season, with Grant Lynch the standout in the back line and Tyren Burnie stepping up in the absence of Daniel Collins in recent weeks.

Blacktown, who lost to Manly in their first finals match before taking down APIA Leichhardt in their second, will be hoping their third is the lucky match that gives them a shot at the Championship after the Premiership fell away from them.

In a high-stakes match there is sure to be plenty of fire and fight as both sides give their all in their last shot at the Grand Final.

Sydney Olympic FC 1 (3) – Manly United FC 1 (4) at Belmore Sportsground

Manly United FC have booked their place in the NPL NSW Men's Grand Final, with a sensational victory over Sydney Olympic FC that finished 4-3 in penalties after regular time concluded 1-1.

Olympic's Sam McIlhatton scored the first goal of the match in the 107th minute, giving the hosts the lead, but Manly secured another last minute goal to even the score just before the final whistle, this time through Bruno Mendes in the 122nd minute.

The penalty shoot out provided plenty of excitement as Manly secured a 4-3 victory, sending them and their loyal fans into raptures as they celebrated their incredible feat.

While the victory sees Manly United with a place in the Grand Final at Commbank Stadium, Sydney Olympic will have to take on Blacktown City for their chance at the big show.

Blacktown City FC 2 – APIA Leichhardt FC 0 at Blacktown City Sports Centre

Blacktown City have progressed to the next stage of the NPL NSW Men's finals series after securing a 2-0 victory over APIA Leichhardt in the Minor Semi-Final at Blacktown City Sports Centre on Sunday evening.

Goals to Mitchell Mallia and Jordan Smylie were enough for the hosts to take the victory, with APIA Leichhardt unable to make an impact in the match despite continued attacking pressure through the 90 minutes.

Mitchell Mallia broke the deadlock in the 27th minute with a clinical finish off the back of some high-calibre teamwork from Blacktown, while Smylie doubled their lead in the 49th minute with an impressive acrobatic volley.

The win will see Blacktown City face up against Sydney Olympic next weekend as they fight for a place in the Grand Final against Manly United, while APIA Leichhardt's 2022 season has officially come to a close.

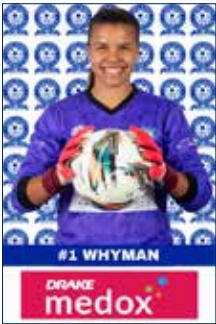
